Distinguished French Educator Award

For a French teacher who has demonstrated long-term achievement and service to AATF and to the profession – locally, statewide, regionally, and/or nationally. **For current AATF-SC members with a minimum of 5 consecutive years as AATF members and minimum of 10 years’ experience** as French educators and with a history of service to AATF.

Recognition of Merit in French Education

Demonstrates/d excellence in the teaching of French language, literature and culture and/or administration of French teaching. **For current AATF-SC members who have been a member for 3 consecutive years preceding nomination and with 5 years’ experience as a French educator.**

New French Teacher Award

For a teacher new to the profession who has demonstrated excellence in French language, literature and culture and leadership in the promotion of language learning and international understanding; has given service to school, community, and state organizations; and has shown commitment to regional and national organizations. **Must be current AATF-SC member with 1-3 years as AATF member and with 1-3 years of teaching experience.**
