Depending on availability, you will be able to choose between four screenings of the same film from **Tuesday April 20th to Friday April 23rd, 2010**. The session is expected to last **2 hours and 30 minutes**, which includes a Q/A session with the filmmakers, based on their availability.

The selected film will suit American audiences, and will be appropriate for youth, ages 15 and older. Admission is free. Each school will be responsible for transportation of its students and insurance issues pertaining to this off-campus field trip.
